- Maximum 2000 words
- Title of the paper - 20 points font size
- Name of Author(s) and their complete affiliation i.e. College/Institute name, Affiliating University etc.
- Abstract (Maximum 200 words)
- Keywords (Maximum 5)
- APA Style Reference should be used
